A steep buttress about 18m high, covered in good holds. Fun climbing. Faces SE and catches the morning sun. Go past Raven's Castle and up the hill as for Grand Canyon. Near the top of the hill, follow a trail to the left toward a steep wall. Routes are described left to right.

1. Matchstick Man

5.12a

6 bolts. Up the first steep buttress where the trail meets the wall. 5.10 until the last two boulder-type moves. The other routes are much better quality.

2. Light Duty Power Pack

5 11b

8 bolts. Fantastic fun - deservedly very popular. After the first moves, it is mostly bucket tugging up a steep wall.

3. AN Other

5.11c

7 bolts. Start as for Light Duty but stay right and clip a 2nd bolt up to the right. Head up from here. Some go to the 3rd bolt of Light Duty (clip the righthand bolt) before stepping right.

5.11c

9 bolts. A tricky start leads to steep, yet surprisingly straightforward climbing to a final overhang.

5 11c

7 bolts. Steep moves to begin lead to a rest ledge before the moves into the exit groove. A few bolts could be repositioned.

7 bolts. The best route at Werbworld. To the right of Strange Brew, step off the ledge and up through several bulges. Surprisingly good holds.
